Equipment (used is okay):

clipboards or bigger pieces of board for outdoor drawing
plexiglass sheets to use as paint palettes

Supplies (new or gently used):

white paper
lined paper for writing assignments (3-hole notebook filler or legal pads are fine)
pencils
pencil sharpeners (hand held)
bingo dot markers (if you no longer play bingo)
markers
glue sticks

plastic gallon milk jugs (for projects like making African masks)
margarine containers
cottage cheese containers, big and small
wood scraps (for sculptures)
PVC pipe, especially elbows
mardi gras beads (for decorating)
plastic cookie cutters (for use with Model Magic and clay)
